



Sweet pitcher plant



Plant Botanical Name:

Sarracenia rubra Walter

Plant Sub Species or Variety:

ssp. *Rubra*

Also known as the sweet pitcher plant, *Sarracenia rubra* Walter ssp. *Rubra* occurs throughout the southeastern United States in wet, boggy areas. *Sarracenia rubra* has a wide variety of forms leading to differing taxonomy. Some botanists debate the classification as a scientifically separate population. These debates make it challenging to consistently classify and adequately protect the wild endangered forms of *Sarracenia rubra*. All forms of *Sarracenia rubra* also face peril due to habitat loss from development and agriculture, altered water tables, fire suppression and poaching. It
